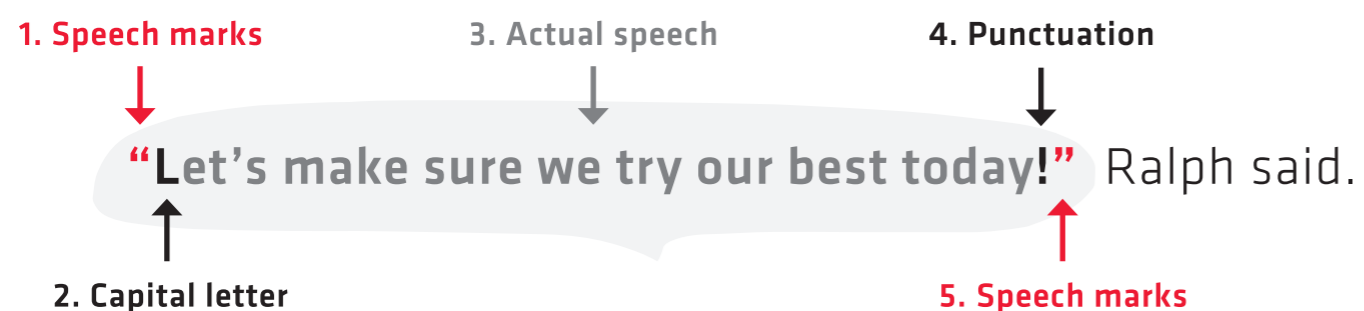




# I PUNCTUATION AND GRAMMAR

Speech marks are needed in a sentence when there is direct speech from a character or person within writing. The punctuation when writing direct speech is written in this order:

“Do you want to meet the players?” said Oriol Romeu.

“Great tackle,” replied Yan Valery.

“Saints won the match today!” bragged Ralph.
